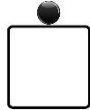
ON, IN, AT, TO

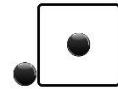
ON – surface

- in the sky

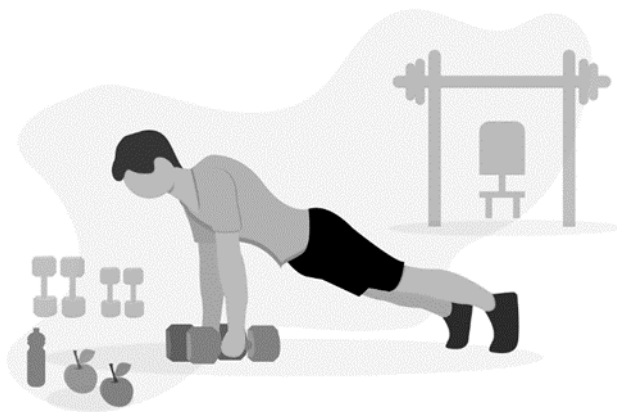
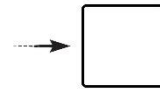


IN/AT

TO – movement towards some place (with verbs of movement)

- I went to work.
- Amelia flew to Italy.
- He drove to Paris.
